DAY 15 – Mark 10:14 – Our MPC Children's Ministry

"Let the little children come to me. Don't stop them, because the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. -- Mark 10:14 (CSB)

Prayer Points:

- Wisdom and strength for children's ministry leaders and volunteers.
- More volunteers to serve and nurture the next generation.
- Children to come to saving faith early and grow in the Holy Spirit's guidance.
- Spirit-filled Sunday gatherings where children encounter Jesus in meaningful ways.
- Thank God Sandi Carlisle and the entire BRJ Team who plan, prepare and participate in the discipling of our children each week.

DAY 16 – Jeremiah 29:7 – Our Local Community (Muckamore & Antrim Area)

Pursue the well-being of the city I have deported you to. Pray to the Lord on its behalf, for when it thrives, you will thrive.” --

Jeremiah 29:7 (CSB)

Prayer Points:

- Blessing on local businesses, schools, healthcare workers, and community services.
- God’s help for those struggling with addiction, mental health crises, and social pressures.
- A powerful move of God among those who do not yet know Christ in Muckamore, Antrim, and surrounding areas.
- The gospel to reach many families, young people, and older residents with hope and new life.
- Ask God for the thriving of public service and servants in our town area. Hospitals, GP Surgeries, Pharmacies, Residential Care Homes, Schools & Colleges, Day Centres.

DAY 17 – Psalm 100 – *Building relationships to the ends of the earth*

Let the whole earth shout triumphantly to the Lord! Serve the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. Acknowledge that the Lord is God. He made us, and we are his — his people, the sheep of his pasture. -- Psalm 100:1-3 (CSB)

- Pray for the nations, particularly where PCI has connections or where Christians face persecution.
- Pray for PCI global mission workers and for fruit from the World Development Appeal.
- Pray for Ireland north and south, and for PCI deaconesses, workers, and residential-care staff.
- Pray for effective outreach to those who do not yet know Jesus.
- Praise God for the gift of faith and remember the Scriptures and moments when He has clearly guided you.

**DAY 18 – Romans 10:14–15 – European Mission Fellowship –
Partnership with Tomáš Henzel (Slovakia)**

How, then, can they call on him they have not believed in? And how can they believe without hearing about him? And how can they hear without a preacher? 15 And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news. -- Romans 10:14-15 (CSB)

Prayer Points:

- Pray for Tomáš Henzel, his family, and his ministry through Paradox Church & EMF in Slovakia.
- Bold, clear gospel proclamation in a spiritually needy region.
- Strength in discipleship, mentoring, and church leadership development.
- Protection from discouragement and renewal in prayer and the Word.
- Fruitful relationships in the community and open doors for evangelism (Colossians 4:3).
- Provision for ministry needs, travel, and resources.

DAY 19 – Psalm 96:8–9 – Worship at Muckamore

Ascribe to the Lord the glory of his name; bring an offering and enter his courts. Worship the Lord in the splendour of his holiness; let the whole earth tremble before him. -- Psalm 96:8-9 (CSB)

Prayer Points:

- A deepening heart of worship across MPC – seeking God's presence above all.
- Guidance for Stephen, Jane, musicians, choir, praise group, and the Sound Team.
- A lifestyle of worship throughout the week – home, work, relationships, service.
- Worship marked by joy, reverence, and Christ-centred praise.

DAY 20 – Romans 12 – *Building relationships in my Church Family*

For by the grace given to me, I tell everyone among you not to think of himself more highly than he should think. Instead, think sensibly, as God has distributed a measure of faith to each one. 4 Now as we have many parts in one body, and all the parts do not have the same function, 5 in the same way we who are many are one body in Christ and individually members of one another. -- Romans 12:3-5 (CSB)

- Thank God for our church family and those who have shaped your faith.
- Pray for our minister, Stephen, assistant minister, Matthew and for a deep sense of God's presence in all gatherings.
- Ask God to strengthen discipleship and equip His people for daily service.
- Pray that our church family will be welcoming, united, and growing in community.
- Pray for healing where relationships are strained and for fruitful outreach to the local community.

DAY 21 – Romans 13:1–8 – *Building relationships in our politics*

Let everyone submit to the governing authorities, since there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are instituted by God. -- Romans 13:1 (CSB)

- Pray for those in government and public office across the UK and Ireland.
- Pray for HM The King, First & Deputy-First Minister in Stormont and the President of Ireland.
- Pray for wise governance in Westminster, Stormont and Dublin, especially on issues affecting schools, healthcare, and vulnerable people.
- Pray for protection of life, compassion in legislation, and healing where political divisions run deep.
